



European Instrument for Democracy and Human Rights delegation of European Union for Bosnia Herzegovina (2013-2014)



The project *Yes Equality: Integrating civil society generational perspectives in combating all forms of discrimination against women and girls*, is a project financed by European Union, started in January 2013 and will end in June 2014.

The project aims to achieve the following objectives to strengthen the role of civil society in *promoting women and girls' right* empowering its critical conscience and dialogue's capacity, through the acquisition of cultural awareness and expression, and social/civic competences.

Yes Equality aims to promote the rights of women and girls within civil society. Through a concrete action aimed at the creation of new models and strong alternatives to those existing in the municipalities of Stolac and Brekovici, Bosnia and Herzegovina, thanks to an integrating generational perspective.

The implementation of the project requires the involvement of many actors of civil society in addition to the association already mentioned: about 250 children from elementary school, 50 youngsters between 15 and 25 years old from secondary school and 40 adults representing social, political and economic entities of Stolac and Berkovići municipalities.





The methodology used for the realization of the project are various:

- Dialogue between project staff and teachers of the primary schools identified, promoted to organize „drawing days“ methodology.
 - Organizing „drawing days“ for children
 - Children elaboration of a story based on their drawings
 - Open exhibition of drawings and stories in schools
 - Organization of laboratories of video-reporting for youngsters
 - Realization of a collective video-documentary on dynamics related to the condition of women and girls by youngsters
 - Public projection of youngsters' documentary and debate
 - Meetings among stakeholders on women and girls situation at local level
 - Stakeholder's realization of an Impact Manifesto
 - Awareness raising campaign



The goals it aims to achieve the project *Yes Equality* to benefit the civil society of Stolac and Berkovići. The estimated results are a civil society aware and its critical conscience empowered on women and girls rights and roles through children reflections through artistic activities and the dialogue promoted by social, politic and economic stakeholders to identify and implement concrete actions for a strong and alternative model regarding women and girls roles and rights in their own Areas of Intervention.

Finally a role in raising awareness on women and girls discrimination strengthened in Stolac and Berkovići municipalities.
